Start at St Stephens Green shopping centre and then walk to pedestrianised Grafton Street which is the most up market shopping area. The surrounding streets including Anne St, Dawson St, Wicklow St and Clarendon St are also good. Then walk along Westmorland street, over the river Liffy at O'Connell Bridge and down O'Connell Street. Turn left at Henry Street where you will find Arnotts and the ILLAC centre. Walk back down Liffey Street and over the picturesque Ha'Penny bridge into Temple Bar, which is famous for its bars and nightlife, through Merchants arch into Cope Street which has another good selection of boutiques.
