The shopping areas of Paris have been split into five sections:

Les Halles

Good for junior and jeanswear stores especially the underground forum, use the Porte Eustace entrance.

Avant-garde fashion boutiques are found at Place de Victoires.

Left Bank

Rue du Four and the adjacent streets are a hot spot for footwear and accessory boutiques.

L'Opera

Here are Paris' two main department stores.

Right Bank

Right Bank is the place for couture shops and the individualistic store, Colette. Tuileries metro is closest.

Champs Elysées

The home of the Louis Vuitton flagship store. Take the metro to Georges V.

Le Marais

An arty studenty area that is worth a look if you have the time.

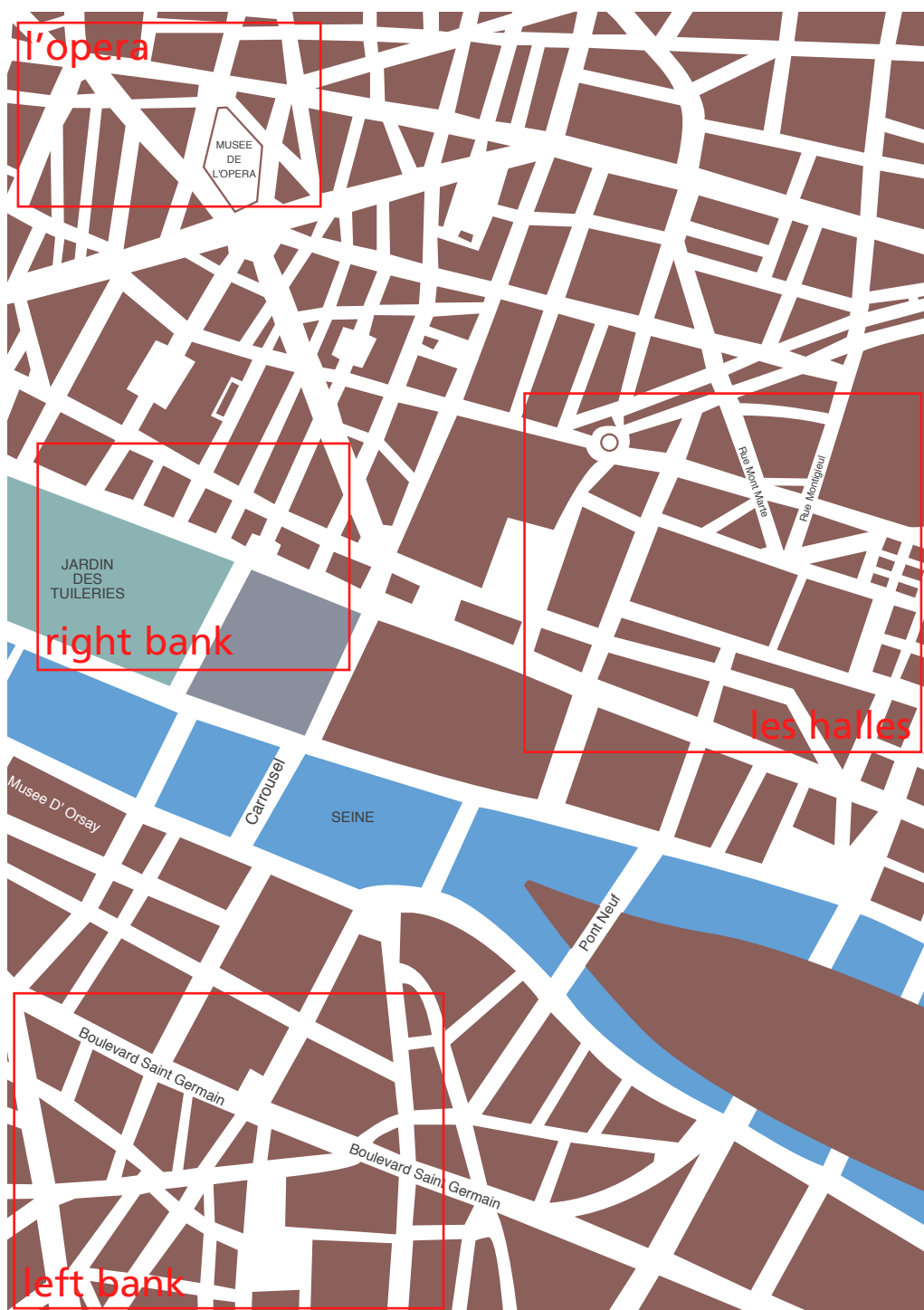
getting around

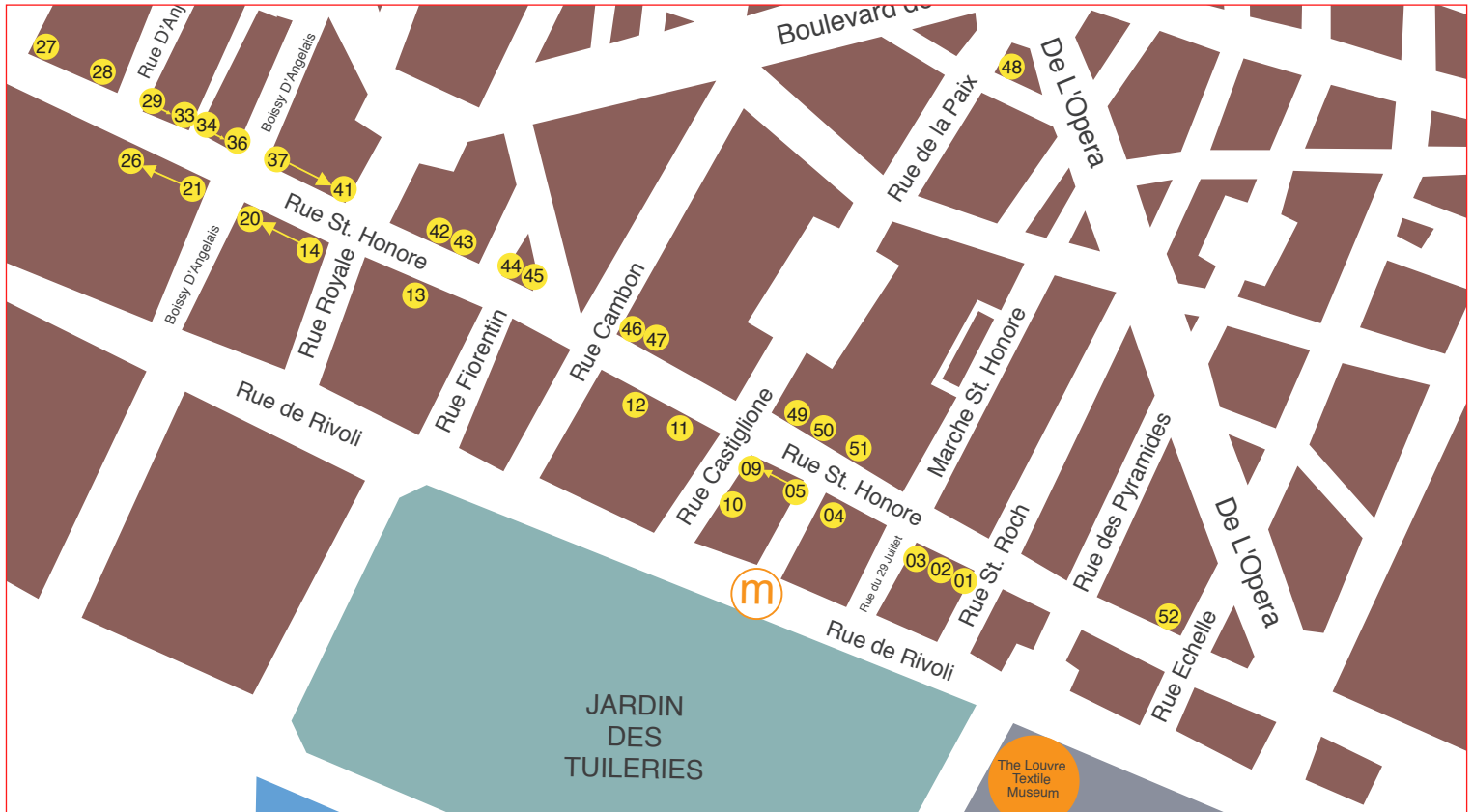
